Research has shown that summer reading loss is cumulative over time. By middle school, students who lose reading skills over the summer have accumulated a two-year lag behind their peers.

Between now and the first day of school any student who reads 30 or more passages and successfully answers the comprehension questions will receive a prize during the first week of school.
