Submit your best work to the Chattahoochee Valley Libraries 7th annual Young Adult Art and Literature Magazine (the YAM)! The YAM is part of our mission to provide area teens a space to share their creativity with their community. Print copies will be available for check-out at all seven or our Chattahoochee Valley Library branches and published online for the public to enjoy.

We will celebrate the achievements of our participants with an open house in our Columbus Public Library Teen Department on Saturday, April 27th at 3:00pm. Pick up your copy of the YAM, enjoy some refreshments, and take photos in our photo booth! Formal invitations will be emailed to those whose work is published closer to the event."

### **Submission Guidelines:**

- Area teens in grades 6 through 12 may submit original works of art or literature.
- Teens may submit 1 piece for consideration. Send us your best work.
- · All work must be submitted electronically. No physical copies of work will be accepted.
- All work must be submitted with the application. Application can be scanned or
  photographed and attached to the email. Use the file name Last Name\_First Initial\_Application
  (example Smith\_J\_Application). If teen is 17 or younger the application must include the
  signature of parent or guardian.
- Label your submission as follows: Last Name\_First Initial\_Art or Lit\_Title of Work (example: Kahlo\_F\_Art\_The Two Fridas or Gaiman\_N\_Lit\_Coraline)
- Artwork must be saved as a high-resolution .TIFF, .EPS, or . PSD file. Suggested resolution is 300dpi.
- Written submissions must be saved as .DOC file. Word count is 1,000 words or less.
- Please use Calibri 12pt font with 1.5 spacing.
- Written submissions will be published as-is and not edited for spelling or grammar. It is suggested
  that authors have someone review their work prior to submission. If you have a library card you may
  submit your work to Brainfuse for review.

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
#### **FOR PARENT:**
