



**Aaron Cohn Middle School
2019-2020
School Improvement Plan Summary**



The school improvement planning team of Aaron Cohn Middle School met to discuss and review relevant data, as well as, review the Comprehensive Needs Assessment for the 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan. The team identified, collected, and analyzed data from Georgia Milestones, CCRPI, Achieve 3000, school climate surveys, Georgia Student Health Survey 2.0, Georgia Parent Survey, Infinite Campus attendance, discipline, and SLDS. Using an ICEL/RIOT Matrix to analyze data, needs were identified and prioritized to guide in formulating two measurable and attainable goals for the 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan:

- School Climate Goal: By May 2020, 100% of teachers will actively utilize relationship building strategies to enhance collaborative planning.
- Instructional Goal: By May 2020, Aaron Cohn Middle School will increase academic performance to meet the state target in the areas of English Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies on the Georgia Milestones Assessment.

The School Climate Goal was developed due to a need indicated by the CNA. It was identified that Aaron Cohn Middle School needs to create more opportunities for teachers to work corporately with each other and foster better working relationships. The Instructional Goal was developed based on 2018 GMAS data and Achieve 3000 data that indicated a need for student subgroups to bridge the gap within achievement. According to the 2018 GMAS, closing the gap was an indicated need in all content areas except mathematics.

A detailed list of action strategies was developed, with specific artifacts and evidence to be collected throughout the school year. Professional Learning opportunities are scheduled to provide faculty with the information and resources in order to successfully reach established goals. Goals will be monitored by Administration and Academic Dean.
