- Update on Coronavirus: Precautions to minimize the spread of illness

Important Information

With confirmed cases of Novel Coronavirus, now called COVID-19, in the US, we should continue to practice preventative actions as advised by the CDC. The virus can be spread by person-to-person through close contact with each other. There is no specific treatment, supportive care can help relieve symptoms. Please contact your physician or go to the CDC link at www.cdc.gov/COVID19 for more information.

The CDC recommends the following preventative actions to help reduce the spread of germs:

- Practice good hand washing habits, which include using soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Hand sanitizer should only be used when soap and water are not available
- Remember to NOT touch your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands
- Always cover your cough and sneeze with tissue. Dispose of the tissue in a trash can and wash your hands
- Avoid contact with others who may be sick
- Stay home/keep children home when sick
- Remember to clean and disinfect contaminated surfaces (for example: door knobs, telephones, desks)

Because the situation is rapidly changing, the CDC is closely monitoring the situation. Guidance updates will be sent, as needed.
