EAGLE GROWTH CHALLENGE

2020 - 2021 Eagle Progress Monitoring
Each grading period, students will complete their student progress monitoring sheet. If growth is shown in class averages and Achieve Lexile, students will be awarded a pass to be used during the school day and/or cafeteria time.

*Scores must be a 7+ or above in order to be considered. Any grades of 70 and below, will disqualify a child from receiving a pass.

*Lexile growth in Achieve 3000 must occur to receive a pass unless a child reaches the top Lexile within Achieve 3000.

Students who qualify cannot allow other students to use their passes and/or personal cell phones. Students will be given a lanyard with a pass to use. Students must keep up with their passes in order to participate. Replacement lanyards/passes are \$2.00.

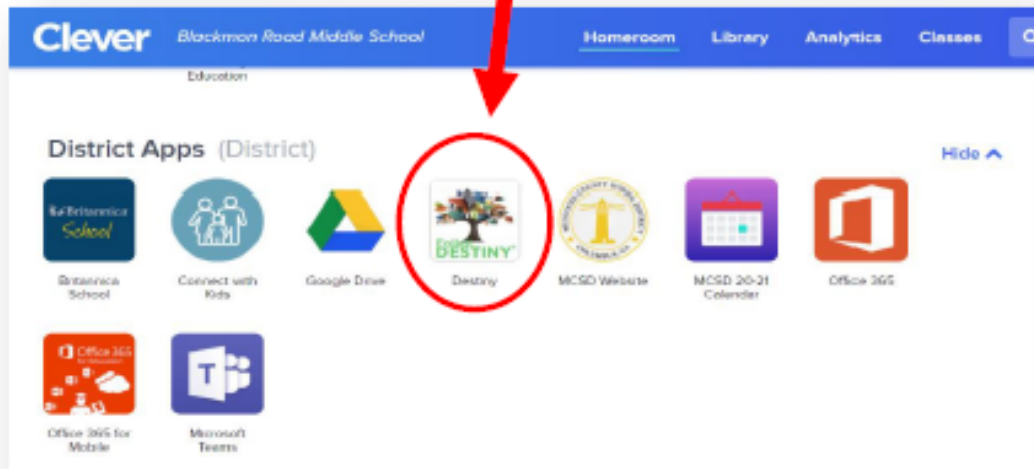

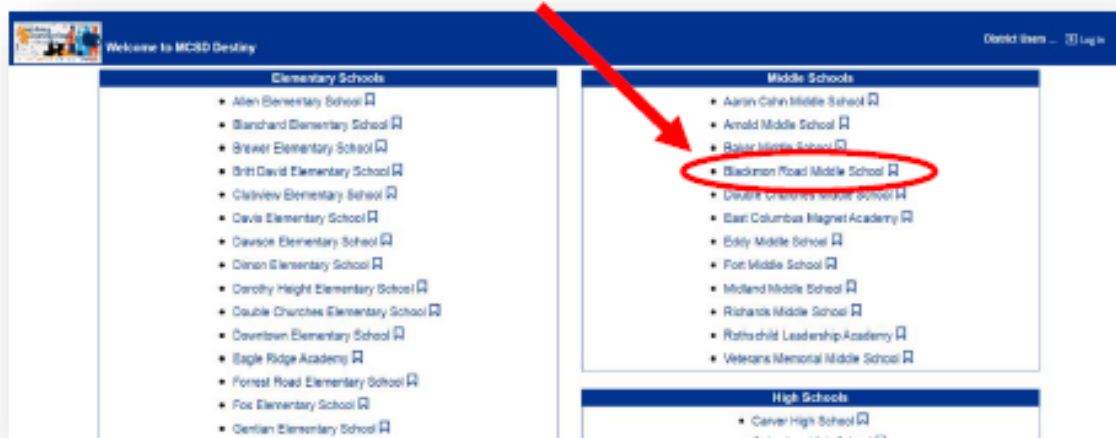
Calling all readers!!

We have a system in place to enable you to check out physical books from the library and return them. There may be a few "kinks" to start with, but we will figure it out and keep going. You may check out 2 books at a time.

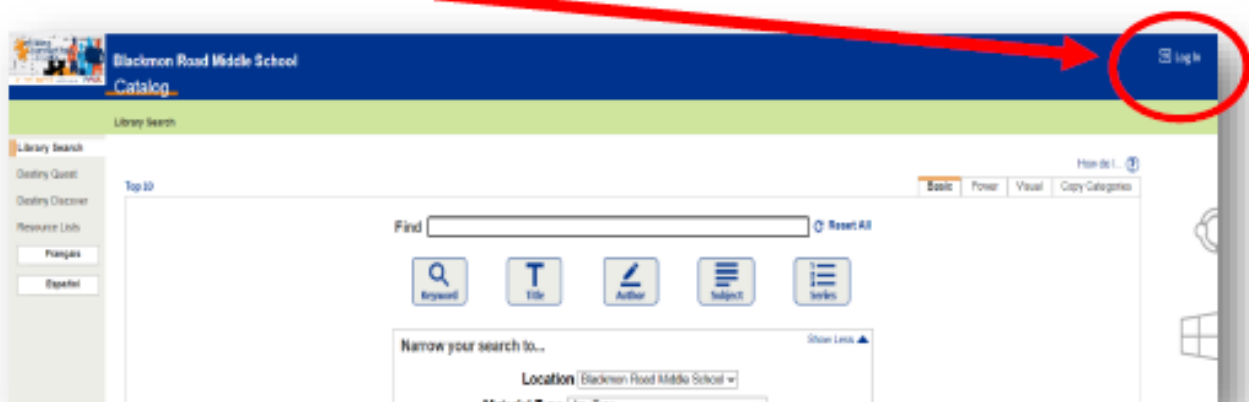
1. On your Clever screen click on the Destiny icon.



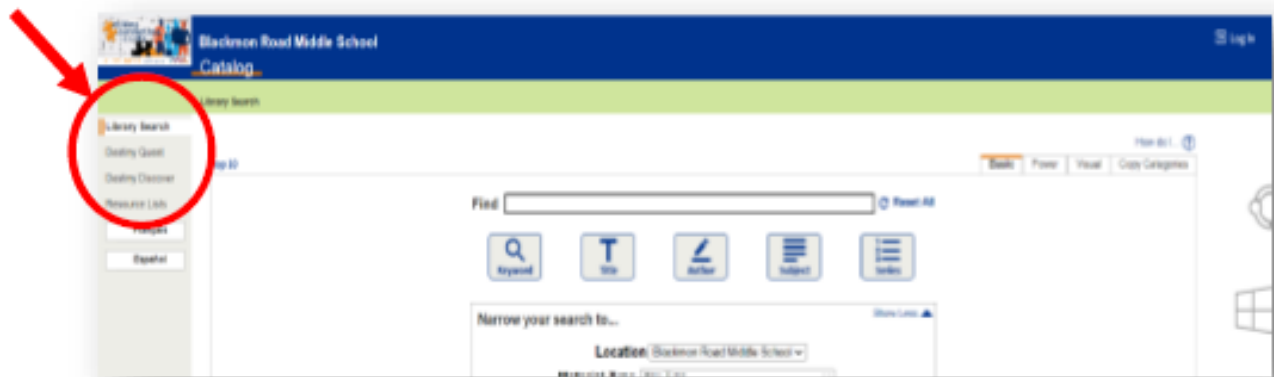
2. On the next screen, click on Blackmon Road Middle School



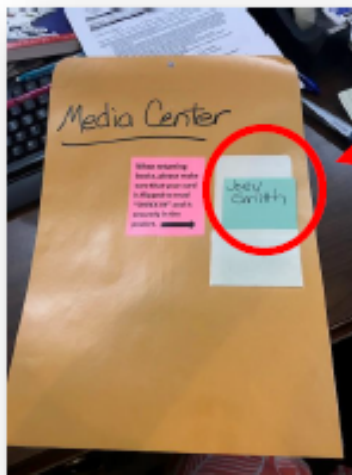
3. On the next screen, click on Log In. Your username and password is the same as your computer login.



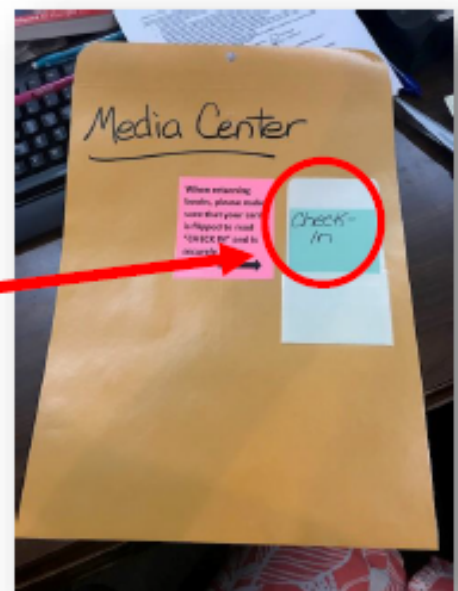
4. After you log into Destiny, you can search the catalog on this screen or you can swap to Destiny Quest or Destiny Discover, your choice. Just click on the one you want from the menu on the left side of the page.



5. Once you find the book you want, click on the book title. On the next screen you should see a "Hold" button. It will be in a different place, depending on which search screen you are using. Click on this button and Destiny will send me a message that you want to check out this book.
6. I will pull the book, check it out to you, and place it in an envelope with your name on it.
7. I will email you through your school email to let you know that it's ready for pick-up.
8. The envelopes will be placed in a large plastic bin outside the front door of the school. Your parents can drive up and take the envelope with your name on it.



9. When you have finished reading the book(s), please place them back in the envelope and fasten it closed. Take the card that has your name on it, flip it over so that "CHECK IN" shows, and put it back in the pocket on the front of the envelope.
10. Your parents can return it to school and place it back in the plastic bin.
