The criteria for exemption of an exam are per class, per nine week period, and are as follows for the next nine weeks:

- A class average of 88 and perfect attendance prior to the • end of the 9 weeks OR
- A class average of 93 for the nine weeks.

*No major discipline resulting in ISS/OSS or more than one Saturday School for the nine week period to qualify.
