An Important Message from the Principal

Parents, your assistance is needed with attendance problems developing with students at BRMS. We have noticed a trend in traditional students choosing to go virtual for the day for reasons that would normally be unexcused any other time. Traditional students may only do virtual for the following reasons: sickness, medical appointments, death in the family, quarantine or isolation.

Due to COVID, please remember the district offered a window for school choice to be made by all parents. An absentee note should be sent in with students when they return on campus or email vanderhorst.tameaka.l@muscogee.k12.ga.us for virtual students. This will determine if a child's absence is excused or not.

We also want to encourage you to monitor the following for virtual students learning from home. Is your student attending class in its entirety? Check parent portal in Infinite Campus for tardies and absences. Is your child avoiding distractions while working from home? TV off, cell phone put away, and video games off? Is your child posting on social media during the school day?

Our teachers are working harder than ever to make sure students are prepared for the next grade level. Please continue to partner with us to provide your child with the best opportunities to succeed.
