

Due to COVID, please remember the district offered a window for school choice to be made by all parents. An absentee note should be sent in with students when they return on campus or email <code>vanderhorst.tameaka.l@muscogee.k12.ga.us</code> for virtual students. This will determine if a child's absence is excused or not




