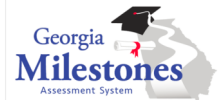

Important News from the Cafeteria

Students, we need your help! Many of you are still failing to make your lunch selection by **9:25 AM** each morning. Please be reminded of the following:

- If you fail to meet the 9:25 deadline, you will be served a sandwich lunch. (Un crustable)
- If you write in a choice that is not one listed on the menu, you will be served a sandwich lunch (Un crustable)
- If you do not make a selection at all, you will be served a sandwich lunch.

Our cafeteria works very hard to offer our students choice in lunches daily; however, students must make their selection each morning from **8:20 AM to 9:25 AM** on their Chromebooks to give the cafeteria time to prepare their lunches for delivery. BRMS does not allow all students to visit the cafeteria lines but has lunches delivered to classrooms as we continue to make our dining environment safe for our students.

- Your Power Cord (charger)
- Your Case

You do not get free replacements for damaged or lost cords or cases. If a new one is needed, the replacement costs are \$41 (cord), \$15 (case) and \$423.25 (Chromebook).* At the end of the year, you will be responsible for turning in all three of these parts.

READ TO SUCCEED ² CONTEST WITH Achieve3000

REGISTRATION

Your school must enroll in the contest in order to participate. Teachers and principals can enroll their schools by logging into Achieve3000 anytime from February 22 through March 7 and clicking "Register" on the notification that appears. Educators can also register for the contest by visiting their Notification Center and clicking "Register" in the Read to Succeed message there.

Once one educator in a building registers, the entire school will be registered for the contest. Be sure to register before March 8!

RULES

Once your school has registered for the contest, 75% of students in your class must complete at least eight multiple-choice activities between Monday, March 8 through Friday, April 9.

Each activity completed earns your class one point. For every first-try score of 75% or higher, your class earns two points. And for every score of 88% or higher, the class earns three points! The winning class is the qualifying class of five or more students with the most points on average, per student, in each registered school. If there is a tie, a winner will be randomly selected.

NOTE: If you belong to more than one class, be sure to select the correct class when logging in. Work will be credited to the class selected upon login.

PRIZE

At the end of the contest, the class with the most points on average, per student, wins a \$25 Visa gift card to spend on a celebration of their choice, prizes, or however they'd like. The teacher of the winning class will receive an email in their Achieve3000 mailbox with instructions for claiming their gift card!
