Verification Day Information

Verification Day is Friday, August 2, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Registration packets were mailed on Monday, July 22nd. Please make sure that you fill in every line on every page. Please note, it will be extremely important that you provide us with working phone numbers where you can be reached at all times.

On Verification Day, you will also be able to sign up for after school care, join PTO (\$5.00), and request bus transportation. The school clinic worker will be available, if you have any medical concerns. In addition, you will receive a supply list from your child's teacher.

Proof of address is needed...

If you have moved, please provide two forms of proof of address (lease agreement/mortgage agreement/property tax receipt AND a current utility bill) to your neighborhood school.

If you are living with someone and the items mentioned above are in someone else's name, you will need to follow the protocol below.

- 1) The person you are living with must be present with a driver's license or a passport.
- 2) You must provide your driver's license or your passport for an affidavit. If you are new to the school district, you will need your child's birth certificate and social security card as well.

If you are returning to the school and you have an initial affidavit on file, you will need a signed letter stating you are still residing at that address from the person you are staying with each day. Additionally, you will need two documents as proof of address mentioned above and a letter with your name and that address on it.
