

Lesson Plan for School Closing:

Kindergarten

Day 1:

- 2 Alphabet Pages - color pictures that begin with that sound.
- 1 Sight Word Page - trace, color, and spell the sight word.
- 1 Handwriting Page - write each letter 6 times.
- 2 Math Pages
 - Addition (plus 0) - anything plus 0 equals the other number.
 - Circle the number that matches the objects.
- Read a book and play a computer game.

Day 2:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color pictures that begin with that sound.
- 1 Sight Word Page - trace, color, and spell
- 1 Handwriting Page - write each letter 6 times
- 2 Math Pages
 - Number 11
 - Addition with 1 – any number plus 1 goes up a number on the number line.
- Read a book and play a computer game.

Day 3:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color pictures that begin with that sound.
- 1 Handwriting Page – write 6 of each word.
- 1 Sight Word Page – trace, color, and spell.
- 2 Math Pages
 - Number 12
 - Addition plus 2 – students can use any small object to help them count
- Read a story and play a computer game.

Day 4:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color pictures that begin with that sound.
- 1 Handwriting Page – write 6 of each
- 1 Sight Word Page (is) – trace, color, and spell
- 2 Math Pages
 - Number 13
 - Addition with 3
- Read a story and play a computer game.

Day 5:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color the pictures that begin with that sound.
- 1 Handwriting Page – write 6 of each letter
- Sight Word Page (it) – trace, color, and spell
- 2 Math Pages
 - Number 14
 - Addition with 4
- Read a story and play a computer game.

Day 6:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color pictures that begin with that sound
- 1 Handwriting Page – write 6 of each word
- Sight Word Page (me) – trace, color, and spell
- 2 Math Pages
 - Number 15
 - Addition Sums to 5
- Read a story and play a computer game

Day 7:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color pictures that begin with that sound
- 1 Handwriting Page – write 6 of each letter
- Sight Word Page (my) – trace, color, and spell
- 2 Math Pages
 - Number 16
 - Addition Sums to 10
- Read a story and play a computer game

Day 8:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color pictures that begin with that sound
- 1 Handwriting Page – write 6 of each letter
- Sight Word Page (to) – trace, color, and spell
- 2 Math Pages
 - Number 17
 - Addition Sums to 10
- Read a story and play a computer game

Day 9:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color pictures that begin with that sound
- 1 Handwriting Page – write 6 of each letter
- Sight Word Page
 - (up) – trace, color, and spell
 - (red) – color the sight word
- Math Page
 - Number 18
- Read a story and play a computer game

Day 10:

- 2 Alphabet Pages – color pictures that begin with that sound
- 1 Handwriting Page – write 6 of each letter
- Sight Word Page – color orange and yellow
- Math Pages – 19 and 20 write, count, color
- Read a story and play a computer game

If a student does not have access to a computer or tablet, they can use the workbooks that are provided.

Parents can make flash cards of sight words. Go on walks with your child and talk about plants and animals that you see. Talk about the weather and the seasons. Give your child a small job around the house. Talk about your job and what you do. Have fun together!
