RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN

CHECKLIST FOR IN-PERSON STUDENTS

- Wear a mask to school every day and have it on at all times while at school (with the exception of lunch time)
- Bring your Chromebook to school every day, fully charged. You may also bring your charging cord.
- Bring a water bottle with you to hydrate throughout the day (water fountains will not be available to use)
- Upon arrival at school, enter through the doors designated for your ILT (see enclosed chart)
- If you are a bus rider, make sure you pick up your bus pass from the school (September 9 September 11)
- Be prepared for daily temperature checks at the start of each school day, students with a temperature of 100 degrees or higher will wait in the designated Holding Room until a parent comes to pick up the student
- Leave unnecessary books and items at home (No lockers will be issued)
- Remember to wash/sanitize your hands often and maintain social distancing at all times
- Stay home if you are sick

Our School Safety Implementations

- Water fountains will be unavailable. Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle. Water bottles must be transparent and contain only water.
- Sanitation: Teachers and students will consistently disinfect classrooms between classes
- School custodians will consistently wipe down doorknobs and routinely clean restrooms throughout the day.
- Lockers will not be utilized
- Limited textbook checkouts. Online textbooks and resources will be the priority.
- Computer labs will not be utilized. Chromebooks will be used for instruction.
- There will be sanitizing stations located in the Main Lobby, Cafeteria, Media Center, and high traffic areas.
- Teacher and student temperature checks daily upon entering the building.
- Maximizing classroom space.
- Social distancing and masks required. PLEASE NOTE: Masks must be appropriate and cannot contain words, emblems, messages, or symbols that would be in violation of MCSD/DCMS Policies.
- Students that are ill will be separated from others and parents will be contacted to pick up their student immediately.
- Utilize outdoor instruction when possible
- Directional hallways when possible

- Field trips, dances, pep rallies, large group gatherings, etc. are cancelled until further evaluation later in the school year.
- Breakfast and Lunches will be grab and go. Students will be spaced out for safety during breakfast and lunch.
- Classroom seating charts utilized for contact tracing. Students must sit in their assigned seat.
- Routine filter changes to the HVAC system.

STUDENT DROP OFF & PICKUP PROCEDURES AND ENTRY POINTS

There will be 4 entry points. Students must enter through their assigned door, which will be based on their ILT Teacher. Make sure you only enter through your assigned door. Students will have their temperature checked at the entry point every morning; stand 6ft apart as you wait in line to enter. We will strictly enforce these procedures. There can be no congregating before or after school. As soon as school dismisses, students must leave campus immediately, unless under the direct supervision of a coach or staff member.

Help us eliminate congestion in the front door area, please get your student(s) to the school no later than 8:10AM. It will also help if you can drive your child to school.
