## **ECMA NEWS YOU CAN USE**

- Students can pick up a <u>Request for Schedule Change</u> form on Monday, August 20<sup>th</sup> from their ILT teacher. The only classes that will be considered for a change to their schedule are Connections classes. The form must be signed by a parent and a contact number must be provided. Students must continue their current schedule until they have been approved by administration and given a NEW SCHEDULE. Please understand that we will try diligently to accommodate your interest; however, scheduling constraints may not allow for the schedule to be modified this year.
- Students will not be allowed to carry book bags to class beginning Monday, August 20<sup>th</sup>. Students will lock up their book bags, cell phones, ear buds and any electronic devices in their locker before reporting to their 1<sup>st</sup> period class. Students have three locker breaks before 1<sup>st</sup> period, ILT and the end of 5th period. Students will retrieve their book bags and other belongings at their last locker break at the end of 5<sup>th</sup> period. Please remind the

- Did you know? East Columbus Magnet Academy had the highest average Lexile (Reading) growth of all MCSD middle and high schools last year for Achieve3000? We did not do it alone; we were fortunate to have had some awesome parents supporting literacy at ECMA! Thank you! We greatly appreciate you supporting this expectation and monitoring the student progress toward this goal. As a bonus we have monthly contest where students from each grade level win prizes such as gifts cards to IHOP, Butterball turkey at Thanksgiving, Ham at Christmas, and catered breakfast from IHOP during 1st period. Last week, your child took the Level Set assessment in Achieve3000 to determine their Lexile level. Be sure to talk with your child about their goal of passing 3 Achieve3000 articles a week. Lastly, students that meet the aforementioned expectation and increase their lexile score will participate in our Annual Lexile Luau in May.
