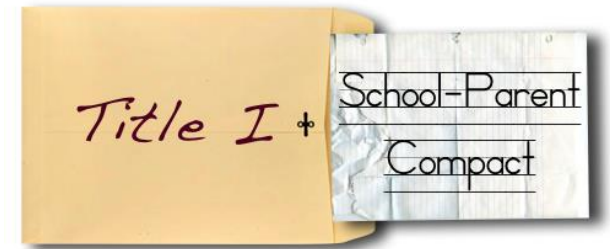
Effective Home-School Compacts:
