Week 3 (Days 11-15)

K-2nd Grade

- **My Musical Instrument Book** – Read about each instrument family and color the instruments, fill in the tiles with the correct instrument name, complete the word search, and sort the instruments into their correct instrument families.
 - OPTIONAL – If you would like to decorate your book:
 - Cut each page along the solid black lines (make sure to not cut off the tabs)
 - Decorate the pages with crayons, colored pencils, or markers (be sure not to decorate/color over the words)
 - Staple the pages together to complete your book.

3rd-5th Grade

- **My Classical Music Book** – Read about each musical period and the composers that were popular during the periods, sort the composers by their correct musical period, make as many words as you can from the letters in “Common Practice Period”, and complete the word search.
 - OPTIONAL – If you would like you can decorate your book:
 - Cut each page along the solid black lines (make sure to not cut off the tabs)
 - Decorate the pages with crayons, colored pencils, or markers (be sure not to decorate/color over the words or pictures)
 - Staple the pages together to complete your book.

Week 4 (Days 16-20)

K-2nd Grade

- **Crazy for Quarter Notes! Packet** – Complete each activity sheet in the packet.
 - Note Maze – Follow the quarter note to the end of the maze.
 - Quarter Note Highlighting – Highlight/color all the quarter notes.
 - Quarter Note Matching – Match all the quarter notes to the one in the middle.
 - Quarter Note Tracing and Drawing – Trace the quarter notes, then draw your own.
 - Color by Note – Use the coloring key to color the correct music note area.

3rd-5th Grade

- **Beginning Music Notation Packet** – Learn about the treble clef, bass clef, quarter note, half note, whole note, piano, forte, and music staff by completing the activity sheets in the packet.

Week 5 (Days 21-25)

K-2nd Grade

- **My Listening Walk Worksheet** – Talk a walk and remember to pay attention to the sounds you hear. When you are done, write down the place(s) you went and draw pictures of the sounds you heard.
- **Color by Music Notes Values** – Discover the mystery picture by using the coloring key to color the correct music notes.

3rd-5th Grade

- **J.S. Bach Article and Worksheet** – Read the article about Baroque composer, Johann Sebastian Bach and complete the worksheet.
- **Color by Music Notes Values** – Color each area the correct color based on the music note or rest.

Week 6 (Days 26-30)

K-2nd Grade

- **Music Symbols Match-up Worksheet** – Use the “Music Clefs, Notes, and Rests” Sheet to match the correct music symbol to its name. Cut out the symbol and glue it beside its name.
- **Treble Clef Line and Space Worksheet** – Trace each note on the treble clef staff, then write a “L” in the notes that are on a line and an “S” in the notes that are on a space.
