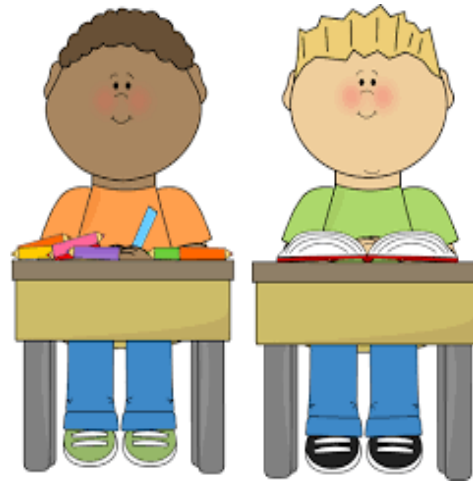
FRE Smart Goals
