Focus walk data shows the focus of TAA sessions observed. 100% of our teachers implemented TAA on a monthly basis.





School Improvement Plan Overview





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Our Goals for 2019—2020 Goal #1 By May 2020, 100% of teachers will be trained on how to effectively utilize gradual release to increase literacy across the curriculum with 80% effectiveness

Goal #2 By May 2020, 100% of the teachers will be trained on 2 modules (rituals & routines and teaching expectations) with 80% effectiveness as measured by PBIS Self -Assessment Survey (SAS), the Tiered Fidelity Instrument (TFI) and observational data obtained through walkthrough data.



Goal #2 Climate Action Plan

- All faculty and staff will be trained on how to effectively implement PBIS through Teachers as Advisors (TAA) to increase student connectedness with the school and decrease the number of discipline referrals.
- Lessons will be provided and models will be given to provide struggling teachers with deeper insight on how to make connections.
- School wide calendar of PBIS/Discipline events and meetings will be developed and followed.
- The faculty, staff and administration will acknowledge and celebrate students reaching learning goals and appropriate behavior to include student interactions taught in TAA through Best Team Transition celebrations, student of the Week, Patriots of the Month and the Patriot Birthday Club Celebrations.
- New Principal will attend RESA Principal's Academy. The skills obtained will be used to help establish a positive learning environment to increase literacy across the curriculum.



Goal #1 Instructional Action Plan

Teachers will be trained on the effective implementation of standardsbased classrooms to engage students in learning.

Teachers will be trained to utilize the 5-step Achieve 3000 protocol effectively using the gradual release model.

Teachers will participate in Professional Learning so that they will be able to effectively utilize gradual release in their classrooms.

Teachers will be trained on how to utilize personalized learning in conjunction with gradual release for effective learning practices.

A student led literacy night will implemented with a focus on reading across the curriculum and literacy strategies to improve student Lexile scores.
