Step 1. Open your web browser. Google Chrome works best.

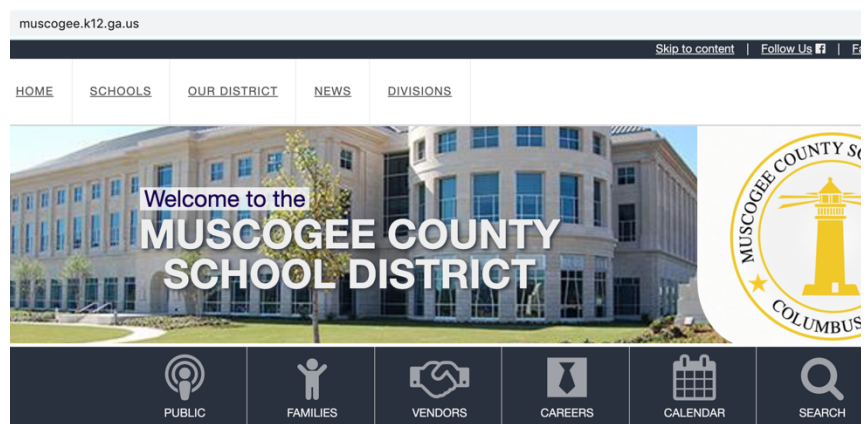
Note: Some Clever content requires use of a laptop or desktop computer. Some can be used from a cell phone, iPad, or tablet with internet access.

On mobile devices, you may need to download free apps to use some content.





Step 2. Go to the Muscogee County School District website. Click on Families.

Step 3. Click on Clever.



<p>Step 4. Click on “Log in with Active Directory.”</p> <p>Note: Some teachers provide QR codes for each student. These should work if you have a webcam or cell phone camera to use at this point. For this option, click on the blue and white “Clever Badge login.”</p>	
<p>Step 5. Students, you will need your GTID # to log in. Parents, you may request this from your child’s classroom or homeroom teacher if you do not have it.</p> <p>Your user name will be your GTID number followed by @mcsdgas.com</p>	
<p>Step 6: Password</p>	<p>For students in Kindergarten through 2nd Grade Your password is initpass</p> <p>For 3rd Grade and up Your password is mc#####</p> <p>The last 6 numbers are the 2-digit month, date, and year of your birth.</p> <p>For example, if your birthday is April, 4, 2007, your password would be mco4040</p>

<p>Step 7: Click on the icon for the program your teacher has assigned.</p> <p>Lexia Core5 Reading works on laptops and desktop computers as well as iPads. It may work on iPhones. Lexia does not work on Android tablets or smart phones.</p> <p>IXL should work on most laptops, desktops, iPads, and Android devices like phones and tablets.</p> <p>Achieve3000 for 3rd-5th Grades should work on most devices.</p>	
<p>Step 7: Login Problems</p>	<p>If you have any trouble logging in or questions about which apps work on various devices, we will do our best to answer your questions! Please notify your child's teacher who will work through the media specialist to help you.</p>
