Do you feel like you won't meet the 3.0gpa requirement? You may not qualify for HOPE as a new college freshman but remember that HOPE reevaluates eligibility at 30, 60, and 90 semester college hours. This means that if you don't qualify as a freshman you may qualify as a sophomore in college.

All you have to do is maintain A's and B's in your GA college to qualify.
