## What do students need to do to participate in dual enrollment opportunities?

\_\_\_ Schedule an individual meeting with Heather Osborn for you and your parent by May 15th Osborn.heather@muscogee.k12.ga.us

\_\_\_Go to www.gafutures.org to complete a transcript request and submit the student and parent dual enrollment electronic application

\_\_\_Apply to the college you are interested in attending

\_\_\_ Take the SAT/ACT/COMPASS (if you have not done so)

Send official test scores from the testing service to the college

COVID update for Fall 2020 Applications:

Colleges are allowing flexibility with the test requirements for ACT/SAT/Accuplacer during this time.

#### Benefits of Dual Enrollment:

- Earn high school credit and college credit with one course
- Get a jump-start on college (students take college courses taught by college professors on the college campus)
- Students may be full-time dual enrollment (all classes at the college) or parttime dual enrollment (some classes at the college and some at HHS)
- Students can participate in fall, spring, and summer semesters (not eligible for summer after graduation)

#### Things to Consider:

- Are you prepared for college level work? Are you mature enough for college classes? You are not identified as a high school student.
- College grades will count in your high school GPA and remain part of your permanent college transcript.
- State funding will only pay for 30 semester/45 quarter hours of college credits
- Failing a college course could affect your HS graduation.
- Students must provide their own transportation.

### **Dual Enrollment Requirements**







- GPA (academic-unweighted) 3.0
- Combined Official SAT score of 1050

The minimum subsection scores must be:

SAT EBRW 480 SAT Math 440

ACT Composite score of 20

The minimum subsection scores must be:

ACT English 17 and ACT Math 17

- Dual Enrollment Participation Agreement submitted to CSU—this is completed during an individual parentstudent-high school counselor meeting
- Acceptance to CSU—Students must meet all requirements.
