

DRESS CODE

SHOES

All shoes must have an enclosed back intended by the manufacturer to serve as such (solid or strap) that holds the shoe firmly to the foot.

MASK FASHION

All masks should follow the MCS D guidelines for appropriate logos, designs, and slogans. Bandannas, shirts, and scarves should not be worn as face masks.

ALL OTHER REFERENCES TO PROPER DRESS ARE LOCATED IN THE STUDENT HANDBOOK.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

Food may only be consumed in the classrooms during breakfast on a staggered schedule to ensure that students' masks are down at a safe distance for a minimal amount of time (15 minutes). No other food, candy, or gum should be consumed in the classroom. Lunch will be consumed in designated areas only.

Outside food is not allowed for breakfast. Lunch may be brought to school with the student, but it must be in a sealed container inside the book bag or in a lunchbox. Outside food may not be brought to students during the school day.

Water is the only acceptable beverage for consumption in the classrooms. Students may bring their own water bottles.

Breakfast is from 7:40--8:00 am (grab and go).

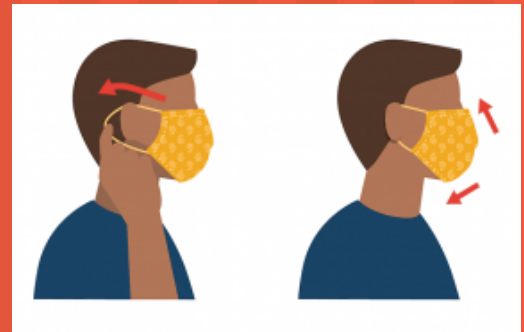

HEALTH & SAFETY

MASKS ARE REQUIRED

Masks or appropriate face coverings (such as gaiters) are required for all students and staff when within 3 feet of any other person while on campus. Face shields may only be worn if approved by the principal (for medical or special needs). Masks must completely cover the nose and the mouth at all times when the individual is in contact within 3-6 feet of others. The mask must be worn as seen below:



GENERAL SANITATION

Students are responsible for helping to keep their learning environment clean and sanitary. Students will be expected to use hand sanitizer as provided as well as clean desks and surfaces when instructed by staff using disinfectant provided by the school district. Students are also responsible for disposing of breakfast and lunch waste as well as cleaning up after themselves in general.

HANDWASHING & BATHROOM USE

Students should practice thorough handwashing throughout the day as needed.

Bathrooms are NOT "hangouts" wherein students should congregate at any time. Students needing to use the restroom should do so for its primary purpose only (not to apply makeup, etc.). Students are to help keep the bathrooms clean and sanitary by properly flushing the toilets and disposing of trash.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

All students and staff should social distance as much as possible during the day with at least 3 feet apart when wearing a mask. Six feet of distance is required if the mask is down. Students are never to congregate in any area in close quarters. Outside sidewalks may be used during class changes.

HALL PASSES

Students are not allowed to be in the hallways or outside during instructional/class time unless approved by the teacher. Hall passes will be issued at the discretion of the teacher. Students in the halls or outside without an official hall pass will be considered skipping and appropriate disciplinary action will be taken.

AFTER SCHOOL

Students are not allowed to be on school grounds after 3:45 pm unless they are participating in a school sanctioned club, activity, or sport. The administration and/or the school resource officer will contact the parents of students who fail to leave the campus at dismissal. Child Protective Services, local police, or the MCSD Police Department may be called for students who are habitually on campus after school later than 3:45.

CHROMEBOOKS

Students are responsible for maintaining the integrity, security, and condition of their Chromebooks during the day. Chromebooks should be fully recharged every night so as to have full power at the beginning of the next day. Students should bring their chargers with them to school in case of an emergency. Students should also change their password and protect their login information at all times.
