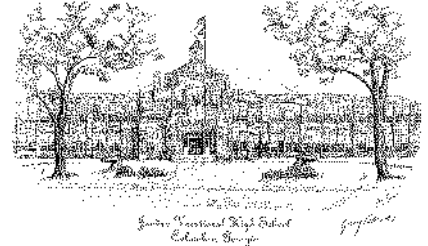

Parents/Guardians:

In order to ensure everyone's safety at Jordan Vocational High School, we will be implementing some new policies and procedures beginning Monday, October 26, 2015. These policies and procedures are outlined below:






- We have been informed by Columbus Police Department that camouflage clothing is being worn by at least one gang in this area as their "colors". To keep students safe and to make sure no one is mistaken as a gang member, camouflage clothing or paraphernalia of any kind will not be allowed on campus unless it is part of the uniform for an official school sponsored activity such as JROTC.
- Students will no longer be allowed to bring book bags to school. Students have all been issued a locker, free of charge, to keep their books and supplies in during the day, and they are encouraged to use their lockers so they do not have to carry all of their books and supplies during the day.
- Any student on campus after 3:45, who is not involved in a school sponsored activity, will be required to report to the cafeteria for study hall and/or tutoring. These students will be under adult supervision during this time. If they are being picked up after school, we encourage them to be picked up by 3:45. If they are on campus after 3:45, they may be picked up in the cafeteria.

Again, these policies and procedures are being put in place to ensure the orderly operation of school and the safety of everyone on campus. I appreciate your support in advising your student to follow these procedures beginning Monday, October 26, 2015. If you have any questions or concerns please call me at 706-748-2819.
