Both tests require that you upload a photo. An acceptable photo of yourself is one that closely resembles the photo on your ID and your own personal appearance on test day.

See your School Counselor to discuss which test is best for you and to obtain a fee waiver.

Students are allowed only 2 fee waivers per test during their Junior and/or Senior year in high school.

It is recommended that Juniors take their first administration of either the SAT or ACT during the Spring semester. Your counselor will make a recommendation during your scheduled Individual Junior Conference.
