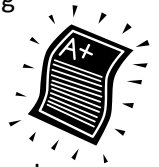
MANDATORY SENIOR PARENT MEETINGS

Now is the time to be signing up to take these tests and completing college applications. You may obtain information in the Guidance Department Office.



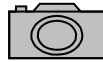
SCHOLARSHIPS

Plans are being made to take the Senior Class Group Picture in **December**. Please plan to wear your Senior t-shirt and be in this picture.

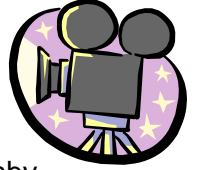


SENIOR T-SHIRTS/HOODIES
