

Jordan Vocational High School
2019-2020 School Improvement Plan

Instructional Goal: By May 2020, 100% of the faculty at Jordan Vocational High School will be trained to implement team teaching and team planning of Tier 1 instruction, with 80% of the faculty effectively implementing these practices as measured by the lesson plans, common walk-through forms, PLC meeting minutes, and TKES.

Action Steps:

- All teachers will be trained on effective co-teaching practices and planning strategies.
- All teachers will be trained on Interdisciplinary team teaching practices and collaborative strategies.
- On-going Tier 1 instruction training will be administered periodically throughout the school year.
- All teachers will notate team teaching practices on weekly lesson plans.
- All teachers will document that team teaching practices were discussed in PLC minutes.
- A common classroom observation form will be utilized to document the Tier 1 instruction and team teaching practices.

Climate Goal: By May 2020, 100% of the faculty at Jordan Vocational High School will be trained on PBIS Framework, implementing 5 of the 10 critical elements with 80% effectiveness as measured by the Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI) and Self Assessment Survey (SAS).

Action Steps:

- Teachers and staff (including non-school based personnel) will be trained on the PBIS framework during pre-planning.
- Ongoing training will be provided to faculty and staff through PLC meetings, PL days, and faculty meetings throughout the school year.
- A team of faculty members will be trained on Restorative Practices and re-deliver to faculty and staff.
- Advisement teachers will introduce the PBIS Framework lessons with students – one lesson per week for eight weeks. The framework will be reinforced by all faculty and staff.
- Faculty and Staff will use the PBIS rewards app to reinforce PBIS practices.
- PBIS information and data will be shared with stakeholders during Faculty Meetings, Local School Council, College and Career Board Meetings, Parent workshops, Open House, and on the school website.
