SUBJECT: Rules for Fort Benning-Columbus Post, 2017 SAME Scholarship

- 1. Four scholarships will be awarded.
 - A. \$2,000 1yr scholarship
 - B. \$1,500 1yr scholarship
 - C. \$1,500 1yr scholarship
 - D. \$1,500 1yr scholarship
- 2. The scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior or college freshman student enrolled in or accepted into an approved 2 or 4-year curriculum leading to a degree in Engineering, Engineering Technology or related program. Student's permanent home residence must be within a 50- mile radius of Fort Benning, Georgia.
- 3. Award of this scholarship will be based on past and present academic attainment, student activities, recommendation, and interest in engineering and/or the military. In addition, enrollment in a ROTC program is a good indicator of interest in the Military Engineering, but ROTC enrollment is not a requirement for scholarship eligibility.
- 4. Award of the scholarship will be recommended by a selection panel in accordance with the by-laws of the Fort Benning-Columbus Post of The Society of American Military Engineers.
- 5. Payment will be made to the student after proof is furnished of enrollment in a school that is consistent with the student's application. Applications must be mailed to the Fort Benning-Columbus Post, SAME, by the student.
- 6. Applications shall be submitted using the application form attached and postmarked no later than <u>Friday</u>, <u>April 28, 2017</u>.
- 7. The scholarship winners will be announced June 9, 2017 at our 20th Annual SAME Golf Tournament on Fort Benning. All winners will be given a free 1 year membership to the Society of American Military Engineers.
