Senior Class Council Members serve as leaders of the Senior Class. As such, they are expected to participate positively to both the Senior Class Council and the whole of Northside High School. Failure to do so may lead to removal from the Senior Class Council. The following list is not exhaustive, and the moderators reserve the right to add to and edit expectations. Senior Class Council members are expected to:

- Attend and actively participate in all Senior Class Council meetings and activities.
 - The SCC will meet approximately every other week at 7:30-8:00.
 - You are permitted four absences.
 - You may have one unexcused absence. A second unexcused absence will result in removal.
 - If you are going to be absent for an excused reason, you must let Dr. Ginther know ahead of time. Excused absences include tutoring or making up academic work, doctor's appointments, illness, or bereavement.
 - You are expected to attend all meetings and events on time.
 - Two tardies equals one unexcused absence.
- Be thoroughly involved in the planning and execution of all events for the Senior Class.
 - You must participate in ALL areas and serve as leaders on at least two committees.
 - Committees may meet outside of the designated time for Council to meet.
- Represent the desires and needs of ALL students in your class in a conscientious and responsible manner.
 - You will be assigned as a representative for an Advisory class. You are to report to your assigned Advisory and make sure that each student in that Advisory is informed.
 - You will bring back to the Council any of their questions, concerns, suggestions, etc.
- You are to be courteous and personable in all of your dealings with students and with faculty members.
- You will maintain at least a 3.0 GPA and have a clean discipline record.
- You should also not be absent/tardy from school on a regular basis so as to cause problems with your attendance.
