Dual Enrollment

- Primarily for Juniors and Seniors who qualify
- Must meet College entrance requirements (Ex: CSU requirements):
 - 3.0 Academic GPA
 - SAT: Combined SAT 970; Critical Reading 440; Math 410
 - ACT: Composite Score 20; English 17; Math 17
 - Must follow all admission requirements from College you are applying to.
- Interested students must fill out DE agreement form:
 - Must be filled out together with Parent/Guardian and Counselor
 - Meeting with student, parents, and counselor must take place by the deadline listed on our website!
 - Students not meeting these requirements will not be able to participate in DE
 - Even if you are planning to dual enroll all students will turn in a pre-registration form!

HOPE Rigor Requirements

- Students must have Four HOPE Rigor Courses on transcript.
- Rigor classes are denoted with a ® on the Pre-Registration form
