



## 2021 IMPACT Scholarship Criteria

## \$2,000 SBMEF IMPACT High School Scholarship

- 1. The applicant must be a female U.S. Citizen.
- 2. The applicant must be a resident of the Chattahoochee Valley Judicial Circuit, comprised of 6 counties. Chattahoochee, Harris, Marion, Muscogee, Talbot, and Taylor counties.
- 3. Both ABWA members and non-members may apply for an IMPACT Scholarship.
- 4. The applicant must be a High School senior and must have been accepted into an accredited four-year college or university seeking a 4-year degree.
- 5. The applicant must have achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- 6. The applicant will email her intent to apply for this scholarship to <a href="https://docs.ncbwa@gmail.com">https://docs.ncbwa@gmail.com</a>; after League approval, she will receive an invitation by email of the application process.
- 7. The application process will require the completion of an online application, uploading a biographical sketch, along with three (3) professional letters of reference dated prior to <u>April 30, 2021</u>. In addition, an official transcript must be mailed by the High School to the SBMEF Trustees.
- 8. The scholarship recipient must attend a minimum of two Chapter meetings during the academic year, the ABWA HCCC December meeting and a second meeting of her choice via in person or remotely. The purpose of this requirement is to introduce her to ABWA and to receive an update on her educational experiences since receiving our scholarship.
