

What is a School-Parent Compact?

A School-Parent Compact is an agreement that parents, students, and teachers develop together. It explains how parents, students and teachers will work toward becoming lifelong learners. Meetings are held each year to review the compact and make changes based on student needs. Parents are welcome to contribute comments at any time. For all students who reside in residential facilities served by the Muscogee County School District, parental involvement correspondence and activities will be mailed to each facility where students reside.

- Focus on student learning skills.
- Describe how teachers will help students develop those skills using high-quality instruction.
- Share strategies parents can use at home.
- Explain how teachers and parents will communicate about student progress.

- By May 2019, 100% of teachers will implement concept mapping and utilize teacher/peer collaboration in their learning and classroom practices with 85% fidelity.
