## Sports Attendance Update Due to Covid19

### Football

Prices for home football games are as follows:

\$5 per adult

\$3 per student

Games are scheduled to begin at 5:15.

**NO students** or children will be allowed into the game **without a parent**  
(These students must then social distance with their parents)

Social distancing must be practiced by all in attendance

No spectators will be allowed inside the track

No spectators will be allowed to sit in the bleachers. Fans should bring their own chair or stand (socially distanced within families)

No one will be allowed to enter the game after the end of the first quarter.

Concessions will be sold at the entrance and will need to be purchased as you enter. The concession stand will close when the admission gate closes.

Masks do not have to be worn once you have reached your social distanced location, but should be worn at the gate, at the concession stand, and when going to and from your social distance location.
