

## **Business Operations Update**

#### Phase-in Return Plan

- We are continuing to monitor information related to the COVID-19 pandemic, with attention to national, state, and local data. Local medical professionals and public health agencies are preparing for possible increased rates of transmission following the winter break.
- Based on current data and advice from our medical community and public health agencies, we will return for the spring semester using a phased in-approach for students
- Each employee will report to his her designated work location, based upon current assignments, following a staggered schedule according to each site starting January 6, 2021.

Phase one: January 6-15, 2021

Choice model: grades Pre-K-5 and self-contained special education

Virtual instruction model: grades 6-12

Phase two: January 19, 2021

Choice model: all students, grades Pre-K-12
