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Cell Phone Infractions:

Cell phone procedures are designed to provide a learning environment that is conducive to teacher and learning without interference. Cell phone use during the course of the instructional day is not allowed in areas such as, but not limited to, hallways, cafeterias, bathrooms, and locker rooms. **No cell phones should be seen throughout the day.**

1st offense: student pick up at the end of the day

2nd offense: held in office for 2 school days, **parent must pick up (no exceptions)**

3rd offense: held in office for 4 school days, **mandatory parent conference with Admin, parents must pick up (no exceptions)**

4th offense: held in office for 7 school days, **ISS for two days, letter sent home to parent, parent pick up**

5th offense: held in office for 10 school days, **Oss for two days, parent conference**

*Richards Middle School asks parents to stand united with us on these consequences. For any offense where the student cell phone is held in the office, if the parent/guardian does not want the cell phone held for the above listed duration, then the parent/guardian chooses for his/her child to accept a two-day in school suspension in lieu of the phone being held.



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
