Dear Raider Parents & Students,

On Friday, October 23rd, the director of Communications for MCSD disseminated information about Qualtrics, a new cloud-based platform the district began using on Monday, Oct. 26th. Qualtrics is a daily health assessment that will be our first step in identifying possible COVID individual exposures and group hotspots. Also, the system will help our district and Shaw:

- Monitor COVID-19 related absences
- Communicate illness protocols to all stakeholders
- Conduct contact tracing
- Initiate steps following a positive result

Beginning this **Monday, November 2nd**, Shaw will launch Qualtrics and the Daily Health Assessment will be emailed to all parent's email addresses we pulled from Infinite Campus. Any parents who did not include their email address are encouraged to do so with the Shaw Administration. If you do not receive an email, you can use the QR code below to answer the survey as well. Emails will be sent throughout the morning starting at 5:00a – 8:00a. However, simply because a student does not complete the assessment does not mean they should not report to school and will not be turned away at any school. Current safety measures will continue to be followed and we ask parents to continue following normal student call out procedures established by the school.

If your student has internet access issues, we will have a QR code available at every entrance for you to complete the daily survey; however, it is not required for students or parents to complete the assessment. We encourage each student to complete the survey because this method will help us to identify possible COVID exposures and provide communication with all parents in an expeditious manner. Qualtrics will not replace our safety expectations. We are still expecting our students to do the following:

1. Complete daily temperature check upon entrance
2. Wear a CDC-approved mask or face covering (please note: alternate accommodations are considered as needed)
3. Stay home if feeling ill or displaying signs/symptoms of illness (please note: students may be transitioned to virtual setting during their self-quarantine)
4. Stay home and not report to any district-related activities or events if sick or observing self-quarantine/isolation (e.g. after-school programs, athletic games, etc.)

Encouraged: Complete the daily health assessment (Teachers will be providing incentives for students that complete the health assessment daily.)
