Ms. Brigitta Stubbs

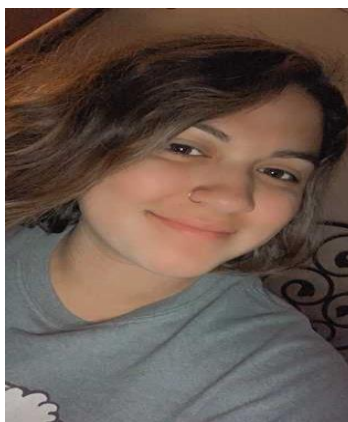

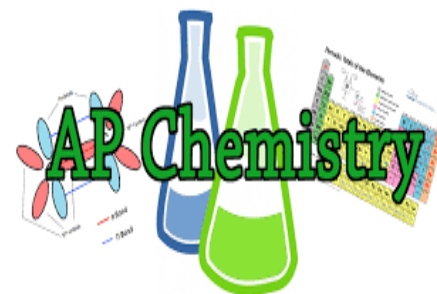


AP Course Spotlight

AP Chemistry

According to College Board AP Chemistry is about the fundamental concepts of Chemistry including structure and states of matter, intermolecular forces, and reactions. You'll do hands-on lab investigations and use chemical calculations to solve problems. Remember to save your lab notebooks and reports. The cutoff for a 5 on most AP tests only requires answering 60-70% of questions correctly.

Through the NMSI partnership, students scoring a qualifying score of 3 or higher on a NMSI AP course receive a check. We had 16 students received \$100 at a celebration held on November 10th.
