#### Getting Started in Credit Recovery:

- Create an account at www.gacreditrecovery.org.
- Write down your username and password.
- Your Credit Recovery Site Coordinator will enroll you in your class(es).

#### Steps to Success in Credit Recovery:

- Complete all course work and post tests by the completion date.
- Have all post tests and final exams proctored by your credit recovery site coordinator.
- Ask your site coordinator if you need assistance.

### What Is Credit Recovery?

- Credit Recovery is an online computer course designed for students to complete with limited assistance. It is a teacherless course.
- Credit recovery is <u>NOT</u> for students who need oneon-one help, or did not get the basic understanding of the course content the first time.
- All non-EOC courses include a final exam. EOCs for required courses for public school students must be taken at your local public high school.

## Creating a CR Account

- Go to <u>www.gacreditrecovery.org</u> and click on the "Log into Credit Recovery" link.
- Click on the "Register" link.
- Click on "Student Account"
- Follow the directions to create your student account.


Now that you have created an account and have been enrolled in class by your credit recovery site coordinator, follow these steps to begin your class.

Log in to <u>www.gacreditrecovery.org</u>

Click on "My Classes"


• You will see your class on the upper right hand side.

#### • Click on your course.



• Click "Content".

• You will now be able to see your table of contents.



- You are ready to take your Unit 1 pre-test.
- Click on the pre-test link to open the test.
- If you score 85% or higher on your pre-test, you will be allowed to go to the unit post test. If you score less than 85%, you will go to the unit content.
- Follow the directions on each screen as you proceed through the lessons.
- After the last lesson you will be directed to the post test.
- STOP before you take the post test. All post tests and final exams must be proctored by your Credit Recovery Site Coordinator.

### Post Test Procedure

- You must pass each unit post test with a 70% or better.
- You have three attempts on the post test. After three attempts, you must have your credit recovery site coordinatorreset your post test.
- Once the unit post test has been reset, you will have three additional attempts to score 70% or better.
- All post tests MUST be proctored by your credit recovery site coordinator.
