



Class of 2021 Graduating Senior Expenses

We are excited about the possibilities that the future holds for you, and we want to make sure that you are able to enjoy all of the opportunities your Senior year has to offer.

First, you need to plan to purchase your cap & gown. The cost of your cap & gown is approximately \$50. Pay this early; the cost goes up if you wait until May, because then you have to pay plant rush fees and expedited shipping. If for some reason you do not graduate, Jostens will refund you your cap & gown fee. You cannot participate in graduation without a cap & gown. **CAP & GOWN FEE IS NOT INCLUDED IN SENIOR DUES! Next, you need to take your Senior portrait. If you have not had your sitting over the summer, you should contact Prestige Studios in Columbus, GA, and make arrangements for this.

Finally, in order to get the most out of your Senior year, it is necessary that each Senior pay Senior dues. Senior dues are based on packages below.

You can pay the total amount or make monthly payments. The first monthly payment of \$70.00 is due by Friday, October 9th. The remaining of your fee is due on or before December 18th, 2020. Please make all payments to Ms. Wyche in the office on the 2nd floor. Cash, money orders, and checks will be accepted. Checks need to be made out to Spencer High School and must include driver's license number and expiration date, as well as a telephone number. You will receive a receipt for all payments made. Senior dues should be paid in full by Friday, December 18th, 2020. A late fee of \$10 will be assessed every month after the final due date.

***Senior Dues include:** Senior Hoodie, Class Composite Picture, Senior Week Activities, Diploma, Senior Teacher Day, Senior/Junior Day, Convocation, and Graduation Fee

****Diploma and Graduation Fees ONLY: \$35.00**

SENIOR DUES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE. Please avoid scheduling family activities on dates of Senior activities and do not get suspended on these dates either. Seniors should be the role models for the underclassmen, so discipline referrals should not happen. **IF YOU ARE FAILING ANY OF YOUR CLASSES OR HAVE EXCESSIVE ABSENCES, YOU WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED A GRADUATING SENIOR!** Please refer to the Student Handbook regarding requirements for Graduating Seniors. **IF YOU ARE NOT A GRADUATING SENIOR, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO PARTICIPATE IN GRADUATION ACTIVITIES.**
