Instructions

1. Parents should click on the Zoom link above for the Title I/Open House Meeting.

After the Zoom meeting, click on the Families and Students portal on the Muscogee County Schools website (<https://muscogee.k12.ga.us/>) and login to Canvas with your child's credentials or pair your Canvas with your child's using the instructions below, at least **24 hours prior**. If you are not going to pair, secure your child's credentials prior to the start of the meeting.
3. Follow your child's schedule utilizing the links provided on the landing page of each course in Canvas.


Pairing Parents with Student Classes in Canvas

Parents can always login as their child, using their child's credentials to see activity in Canvas.

If a Parent would like to follow their child in Canvas as an "Observer" and receive updates of Announcements and Class Activities, they will need the "pairing code" to setup their account.

Step 1: Student must login to get code.


To locate the pairing code, the student must [login to Canvas](#), click on **Account, Settings**, then **Pair with Observer**. The code will appear.




