The Lambda Iota Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. is seeking talented high school students (grades 9-12) with training and ability in music and the performing arts to participate in our **Annual Talent Hunt Competition**. This year's competition will be a virtual competition and the program is scheduled for January 24, 2021 via Zoom at 4:00 PM. The Zoom link for the program is _____.

Certificates will be awarded to all participants and the 1st place winner will receive a plaque for 1st place and \$200 cash prize; the 2nd place winner will receive a plaque for 2nd place and \$150 cash prize; and the 3rd place winner will receive a plaque for 3rd place and a \$100 cash prize.

The first place winner's video will be submitted to the State Level Talent Hunt Competition on January 31, 2021 and will represent the Lambda Iota Chapter at the Statewide Virtual Talent Hunt Competition in February 2021. The top two finishers at the state level are eligible to compete at the District level in March 2021, and the District level winner advances to National competition. Winners at the District and National Level are eligible for scholarship awards. The Fraternity will pay expenses associated with competing at higher levels, if required.

Applications and videos must be submitted by January 15, 2021. A video conference will be held on January 19, 2021 to select contestant, if required. The categories for competition are dance, drama, and music. Please note that the music category is limited to Classical, Gospel, or Jazz.
