SCHOOL UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE POLICY 2019-2020

St. Mary's Magnet Academy implements a school-wide uniform dress code policy. Our school's mission reflects that our student's primary focus during the school day is learning. In addition, uniforms contribute positively to student's behavior and thereby minimize discipline infractions. The uniforms are as follows:

^{*}Fridays are designated as spirit days. During pre-planning and the month of August, we will sell both uniform t-shirts and school spirit t-shirts that students can wear on those days.

SHIRTS/BLOUSES (MUST BE SOLID COLORS)

- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- NO tank tops, spaghetti straps, tube tops or see-through shirts allowed
- NO midriffs should be exposed (including when arms are raised)
- NO solid white t-shirts or undershirts
- NO shirts that advocates drugs, sex, alcohol, violence, gangs, hate, or profanity

PANTS/DRESSES/SKIRTS/SHORTS

- Students may wear **khaki or navy or black** shorts, pants, capris, skirts, skorts or jumpers.
- Shorts and skirts must be no higher than 3" above the top of the knee cap
- Leggings must be worn under a skirt or dress, no belt is required
- Students should wear a belt to keep pants at or above the waist.
- NO oversized pants/bound pants/sagging pants
- Pants with holes are not to be worn (even if leggings are worn under the pants)
- Athletic shorts may not be worn during the school day

SHOES

- For safety concerns, ALL shoes (boys and girls) need to be rubber-soled with enclosed toes and heels; tennis shoes preferred due to weekly physical education classes and recess.
- NO flips flops
- NO slides or crocs
- NO sandals and high heels
