Tryouts:

August 27, 2024, 3:10–4:15– Participants will practice the cheer and dance they learned online

August 28, 2024, 3:10-4:30 pm- There will be an individual and small group evaluation by the coaches

- Students should wear gym shorts and a t-shirt with **no jewelry**, and hair should be pulled up.
- Immediately after school (3:10 p.m.), report to the GYM and get changed.
- On Thursday, August 20th, students will gain access to videos of the tryout material.

Tryouts Consist of: Cheer, dance and jumps

Athletes will be judged throughout the selection process by the coaches based on the following categories:

- Execution
- Difficulty
- Overall Performance showmanship, spirit, athleticism
- Coach Evaluation cooperation, attitude, attendance, dependability (behavior, grades, and discipline reports taken into account)
