Baker Middle School Uniforms 2021-2022

With MCSD Board approval, a school uniform policy has been adopted. <u>ALL</u> students are required to wear school uniforms <u>Monday</u> through <u>Friday</u>.

Boys – 6th grade

- <u>Shirt Navy Blue</u> long or short sleeve uniform polo shirt or dress shirt
- The only items to be worn over the uniform shirt are:
 - Navy Blue or Gray Jacket or Coat (NO HOOD)
 - Jackets and coats must remain unzipped
 - Navy Blue or Gray sweatshirt (NO HOOD)
 - Navy Blue or Gray sweater
 - Navy Blue or Gray sweater vest
 - Official Club or Organization Jackets (unzipped)
- Bottoms Navy Blue or Khaki pants or shorts (belt if needed)



Girls – 6th grade

- Shirt Navy Blue long or short sleeve uniform polo shirt or dress shirt
- The only items to be worn over the uniform shirt are:
 - Navy Blue or Gray Jacket or Coat (NO HOOD)
 - Jackets and coats must remain unzipped
 - Navy Blue or Gray sweatshirt (NO HOOD)
 - Navy Blue or Gray sweater
 - Navy Blue or Gray sweater vest
 - Official Club or Organization Jackets (unzipped)
- Bottoms Navy Blue or Khaki pants shorts, skirts, rompers, or skorts (belt if needed)



Boys - 7th grade

 - Official Club or Organization Jackets (unzipped)

Girls – 8th grade

Student Uniform and Dress Code Policy

Special Notes:

- On Fridays, students may wear any official Baker Middle School t-shirt with jeans (jeans cannot sag, be bound at the ankle, or have holes above the knee)
- Blankets are not permitted
- School ID's will be required to ride the bus, receive PBIS Baker Bucks, attend events during the school day, etc.
- All shoes must be rubber-soled with enclosed toes and heels; tennis shoes preferred
- NO HOODIES
- No oversized clothing, sagging, leggings, hoodies, or high heels
- Non uniform jackets and coats must remain in the hall locker
- Students may carry a clear, mesh, or grocery bag
- Book bags MUST be clear or mesh
- Only one small handbag is permitted
- No logos, insignias or writing on clothes
- No undergarments or printed items visible through uniform shirt
- Administration has the final word on what is/is not permitted.

*Students must wear their ID daily. The ID is used as a safety measure, bus pass, library card, PBIS Reward point tracker, and school event pass. Students will be denied access to activities and opportunities if their ID is not present.

Additional Dress Code and Grooming Items

When students are not in uniform (dress down days), the following applies. It is prohibited for any student to wear clothing items or haircut designs, which contain real or "fake" alcoholic beverages, gangs, drugs, sex, tobacco, obscene, crude or suggestive messages, or profanity. Insignias, satanic symbols, gang related badges and colors or logos and symbols that denigrate religious, social or ethnic groups are also prohibited.

<u>Grooming:</u> Students may not have hairstyles with offensive cuts/parts containing designs or symbols. Students may not have slashes cut in eyebrows. Students cannot write on their bodies.

Shirts/Tops

All shirts must be tucked in

NO HOODIES

No undergarments are to be worn as outer garments, including white t-shirts

No midriffs or shirts that expose students as they move or sit

No see-through shirts/blouses

No tank tops, spaghetti straps, tube tops, off the shoulder, or shoulder cutout

Shoes

No slides, "crocs", "birkenstocks", shower shoes, flip-flops, open toe or heel, or bedroom shoes No high heels except during announced special ceremonies or events

Pants/Bottoms

No Sagging (no visible undergarments to include gym shorts, etc.)

No see-through

No holes above the knee that allows the skin to show

A belt must be worn if not fitted at the waist

No athletic shorts outside of the physical education class

No sweat pants/gym pants and or shorts/ "Wind" suit pants

No pants are to be worn bound at the ankle by elastic, socks or any other means

No tights or "leggings" worn as outer garments

Dresses, skirts, and shorts cannot be more than 3 inches above the top of the knee

Athletics, Clubs, Organizations

During the season/event, current participants may wear uniform items on game, competition, and event days with the expressed permission of the coach, sponsor, or administration.

Coats and Jackets

All approved uniform coats and jackets (navy or gray) or other school issued item, must remain unzipped at all times. NO HOODIES! Coats and jackets not meeting the above criteria must be placed in hall lockers.

Headgear

The following head coverings are not allowed: hats, bandanas, bonnets, wave caps, and "do rags".

<u>Iewelry</u>

Jewelry items with spikes or chains are not allowed. Jewelry should not distract from the learning environment. The school is not responsible for stolen or damaged jewelry.
