A Note From Mrs. Gorum regarding COVID Protocol

BRMS Parents and Students,

COVID continues to impact our district/school and sometimes creates the need for students to be quarantined. Please understand we will work with families during these situations if this happens to your child. If your child becomes ill or has to quarantine, please remember these things.

1. Absences will be **excused** by BRMS during required quarantine periods.
2. Students will continue to work using their Chromebooks by **following their teachers daily on Canvas**. (Attached are simple directions for parent access.) Teachers can monitor students' work time at home through the content filter Go Guardian.
3. Parents and students can see progress in teachers' **gradebooks** 24-7 by logging on using parent/student portal.
4. Students can **email** teachers if they have any concerns and/or questions. Teachers are still available to help students during quarantine time periods. Email addresses can be found on the BRMS website under the staff tab.
5. A **technology support** line is available for our students to access by calling BRMS at 706-565-2998 or calling 706-748-2271.

Remember, we are a **COMMUNITY** here at BRMS, and we will work together to assist our students during this time period. Please always notify us if your child tests positive or has symptoms. Children should not come to school while awaiting COVID test results.

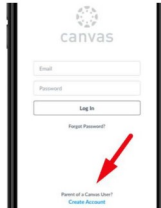


How to connect with your student using the Canvas Parent mobile app.

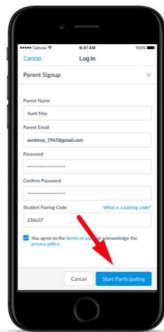
- 1 Download the Canvas Parent app from the App Store or Google Play.



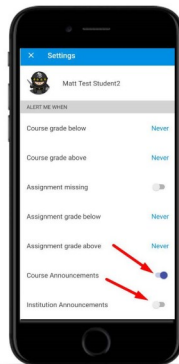
- 2 Open the Canvas Parent app, tap the Find my School button, enter Muscogee County School District and click on the name of the District as it auto-populates.



- 3 Tap Create Account link at the bottom of the login page.



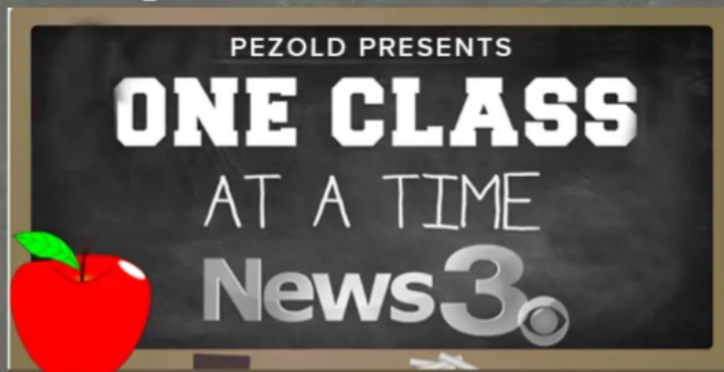
- 4 Fill out the signup form, including the pairing code that was shared with you, and tap Start Participating. Pairing codes are generated by your student. Students will login to Canvas, click their Account button at the top left, choose Settings, and then "Pair with Observer"



- 5 To enable notifications, click on the menu icon in the top right and select "Manage Children". Click on the student's name and turn on Course Announcements and Institution Announcements.
