Progress Reports and Eagle Growth Monitoring

On Wednesday, students will receive their Progress Report and will complete an **Eagle Growth Monitoring Sheet** during ILT. This is a time for students to reflect on how they've done these past four weeks in school. Also, **lanyards** will be issued based on students' grades and Lexile growth.

The flyer on the right gives specifics on what it takes academically to earn our three levels of lanyards:

Cell Phone Pass:

Students may use their cell phones during lunchtime.

Sporty Scholar Pass:

Students may wear athletic wear + cell phone usage at lunch.

Eagle Pass:

Students may wear athletic wear, use cell phones at lunch, and sit where they would like at lunch.

EAGLE GROWTH CHALLENGE

Each grading period, students will complete their student progress monitoring sheet. If grade requirements are met in class averages and Achieve 3000 Lexile growth has occurred, students will be awarded a pass to be used during the school day and/or in the cafeteria.

*Scores must be 71 or above in order to qualify for a cell phone pass. Any failing grades will disqualify a student from receiving a pass.

*Lexile growth in Achieve 3000 must occur to receive a pass unless a child reaches the top Lexile within Achieve 3000.

Students who qualify cannot allow other students to use their pass or cell phones. Students will be given a lanyard with a pass to use for the grading period. Students must keep up with their pass in order to participate. Replacement lanyards/passess are \$5.00.
