## Nine Weeks Exams Coming Soon

Nine weeks exams are given in each academic class. The criteria for exemption are per class, per nine week period, and are as follows:

1. A class average of 88 and perfect attendance prior to the end of the 9 weeks OR
2. A class average of 93 for the nine weeks.

\*No major discipline issues resulting in ISS/OSS or more than one Saturday School for the nine week period to qualify.

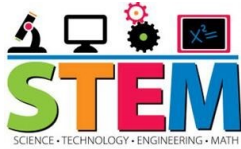
## Interested in the Science Fair?

## A Note From Mrs. Gorum regarding COVID Protocol

BRMS Parents and Students,

COVID continues to impact our district/school and sometimes creates the need for students to be quarantined. Please understand we will work with families during these situations if this happens to your child. If your child becomes ill or has to quarantine, please remember these things.

1. Absences will be **excused** by BRMS during required quarantine periods.
2. Students will continue to work using their Chromebooks by **following their teachers daily on Canvas**. (Attached are simple directions for parent access.) Teachers can monitor students' work time at home through the content filter Go Guardian.
3. Parents and students can see progress in teachers' **gradebooks** 24-7 by logging on using parent/student portal.
4. Students can **email** teachers if they have any concerns and/or questions. Teachers are still available to help students during quarantine time periods. Email addresses can be found on the BRMS website under the staff tab.
5. A **technology support** line is available for our students to access by calling BRMS at 706-565-2998 or calling 706-748-2271.

Remember, we are a **COMMUNITY** here at BRMS, and we will work together to assist our students during this time period. Please always notify us if your child tests positive or has symptoms. Children should not come to school while awaiting COVID test results.
