2021-2022 Nine Weeks Exam Policy

All academic content courses are required to have a nine weeks' test. These cumulative tests developed by our academic departments serve as a measurement of content mastery covered in each academic core area at the end of the grading period. Students meeting the criteria listed below will be eligible to exempt nine weeks' exams in up to four academic core classes: Social Studies, Math, Language Arts and Science.

Exam exemption means a student may NOT be required to take the exam for a qualifying class, and/or the exam grade will not count against the student as they are exempt or will count to replace a low grade. During exam days, daily attendance to school is still required.

Exams are given over a four-day period as established by the school's nine weeks' testing schedule. Students will still have academic work in the remaining classes each day. The criteria for exemption is per class, per nine week period, and is as follows:

1. A class average of 88 and perfect attendance prior to the end of the 9 weeks or
2. A class average of 93 for the nine weeks.

*No major discipline issues resulting in ISS/OSS or more than 1 Saturday School for the nine week period to qualify.

How to Read At-Home Covid Test

Parents, below are the instructions for reading at-home Covid test. A positive test must show 2 lines. A negative test will only show one line.

7 Test Result Explanation

Positive Result

C T or C T or C T

A POSITIVE result must show BOTH a C line and a T line. A positive result means that viral antigens from COVID-19 were detected and the individual is positive for COVID-19.

Below are photos of actual positive tests. Please note that the T line may be faint.

C T C T C T C T C T

Persons who test positive should self-isolate and seek follow up care with their physician or healthcare provider as additional testing and public health reporting may be necessary.

Negative Result

C T

A NEGATIVE result will show ONLY a C line. A negative result means that viral antigens from COVID-19 were not detected and that the individual is presumed negative for COVID-19.
