Have the required doses of Hepatitis B, Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis, and Polio vaccines. 2. Have two (2) doses of Measles vaccine, two (2) doses of Mumps vaccine, and one (1) dose of Rubella vaccine OR laboratory proof of immunity against Measles, Mumps or Rubella. 3. Have two (2) doses of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine OR documentation of disease or laboratory proof of immunity. 4. Have one (1) dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccine and one (1) dose of MCV (meningococcal conjugate vaccine) for children born on or after 01/01/2002. 5. Contact your health care provider to receive any needed vaccinations and to obtain the Georgia Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231).</div>

Parent/Guardian:

As your child's school nurse and clinic worker, we want to remind you of the importance of having your son/daughter properly vaccinated **before entering 7th grade** at Blackmon Road Middle School this fall. Vaccines are the best way you can protect your child from a number of serious diseases, and are required to enroll in school.

Effective July 1, 2014 all children born after January 1, 2002 who are entering the 7th grade are required to have a Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis) vaccination and a Meningococcal Conjugate vaccination before entering school. Vaccinations are documented on the Georgia Immunization Certificate (Form 3231).

Your child **must** have all required immunizations prior to the start of school, unless he/she has a religious exemption. Your child will not be able to enter 7th grade without proper vaccination documentation. The vaccines and the appropriate form are both available at your healthcare provider's office and the Columbus Health Department.

Immunization certificates must meet the following criteria to be acceptable:

- Student name on the immunization certificate must match the name on the birth certificate
- Immunizations must be documented on Georgia Immunization Certificate (form 3231)
- Out of state immunization certificates must be transferred to the Georgia Immunization Certificate
- Immunization certificate must be marked "Complete for 7th Grade or Higher"

We encourage you to make sure your son/daughter has received all appropriate vaccinations recommended for them, prior to the start of school. Schedule your child's appointment today to ensure they are up-to-date on the vaccines required.

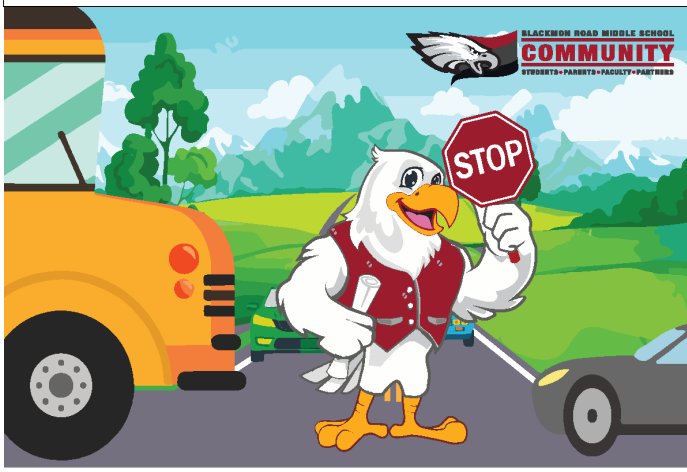

5 Routes to Becoming an MCSD "WE" Educator



TRADITIONAL CERTIFICATION

An educator who has completed a teacher certification program and holds a professional certification through a traditional route (i.e. 4 year college/university or Masters of Art in Teaching (MAT) program).



PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATION

A **Provisional Certificate** is a 3-year, non-renewable certificate given to teachers completing certification through an alternative pathway while teaching.



MILITARY SUPPORT INDUCTION PATHWAY

The **Military Support Induction Certificate** allows Veterans interested in becoming an educator, to ease the transition from service member to a teacher. This certificate will allow eligible individuals to teach for up to three years while completing requirements for professional Georgia certification.



STRATEGIC WAIVER

The **Strategic Waiver Model** allows individuals with degrees in a particular field (i.e. Math, Science, Music, Art, History etc.) to teach that subject area without certification.



GA DECAL BRIGHT FROM THE START/PRE-K LEAD TEACHER

The **Bright from the Start/GA Decal** program allows MCSD to hire Pre-K Lead Teachers without certification. Eligible candidates must hold a Bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited college or university and meet the Georgia Professional Development System for Early Childhood Educators (GaPDS) early childhood requirements.


