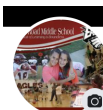

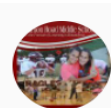

Helping Your Student with Math This Summer Summer Math IXL Plans

If students sign into their IXL account through Clever and then click on LEARNING and then SKILL PLANS, at the top are "spotlight" summer plans, which includes IXL Summer Boost for remediation and IXL Summer Adventures for enrichment. Both plans are 20 days (4 weeks) long. Parents can check their child's progress by signing into their child's IXL account.

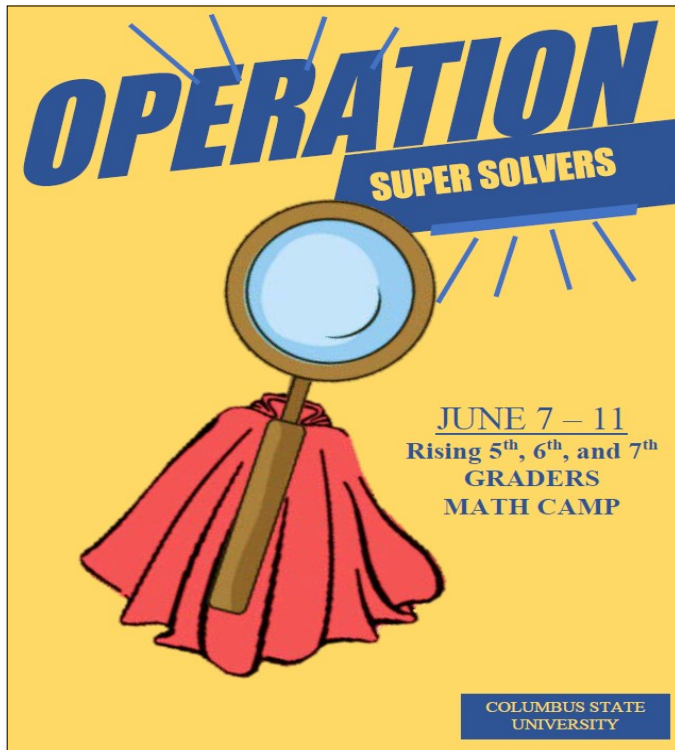
Athletic Eligibility

If your child plans to play sports in the fall, make sure he/she has a passing semester average from this nine weeks and 4th nine weeks. Often, students forget how important off seasons are. Do your work now where you can play later!

IMMUNIZATION RULES FOR 7th GRADE STUDENTS

ALL CHILDREN ENTERING 7TH GRADE ARE REQUIRED TO MEET THE FOLLOWING:

1. Have the required doses of Hepatitis B, Diphtheria, Tetanus and Pertussis, and Polio vaccines.
2. Have two (2) doses of Measles vaccine, two (2) doses of Mumps vaccine, and one (1) dose of Rubella vaccine OR laboratory proof of immunity against Measles, Mumps or Rubella.
3. Have two (2) doses of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine OR documentation of disease or laboratory proof of immunity.
4. Have one (1) dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) vaccine and one (1) dose of MCV (meningococcal conjugate vaccine) for children born on or after 01/01/2002.
5. Contact your health care provider to receive any needed vaccinations and to obtain the Georgia Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231).

The CSU Columbus Regional Math Collaborative has announced a special summer math camp to launch children into middle school math:

Operation Super Solvers!

Columbus State University faculty and staff volunteers are creating this half-day, week-long summer camp designed for children rising the 5th, 6th, and 7th grade who may have missed out on many hands-on, engaging classroom activities because of the pandemic.
