3. Applicant must complete an official Southeast District Scholarship Application by deadline date, March 31, 2021.
4. Applicant must include a statement of your need for a scholarship.
5. Applicant must submit a typed 300 word essay on the following topic: **In view of the present political climate, how have these issues impacted our Country?**

Save and submit your essay in Word format.

Select one issue and discuss:

- (1) Presidential Impeachment
- (2) Voter Fraud
- (3) Gerrymandering
- (4) Voter Registration
- (5) COVID-19

Scholarship Package must include the following:

1. Completed Scholarship Application (typed)
Note – **Late or Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
2. Include a statement of your need for a scholarship.
3. Resume that includes: career goals, GPA, academic awards, scholarship(s) or honors received, community involvement, special skills and extracurricular activities
4. A small photo
5. Two character letters of recommendation (teacher, counselor, principal, other)
6. High school transcript (end of first semester of senior year with the official school seal)
7. Scan and email all documents in a PDF File format.

Note: Save and Submit your essay in Word format.
