### Start In High School. Follow *Your* Perfect Path.

#### High Schools

By participating in high school CTAE programs, students can create opportunities to continue their studies in college, pursue an entry-level job, or serve in a related field in the military. (See back for a full list of programs.)

#### FCCLA

Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) is the Career & Technical Student Organization (CTSO) that gives students an opportunity to participate in career-related competitions across the state and nation, and gain leadership experience, such as three hours college credit to Georgia colleges.

#### Certifications

After completing a CTAE pathway, students prepare for certification exams, at CTAE expense, that may qualify them for entry-level jobs and/or college credit.

#### Work-Based Learning

Students have the opportunity to be released early from school to work in positions related to their CTAE pathways.

#### Direct-to-Work

Rigorous high school programs prepare students for early childhood education careers upon graduation.
